### **Proposed Residents Permit Parking, Ingram Road, Bamburgh**

Residents have raised concerns about parking difficulties in Ingram Road caused by visitor parking. In order to address this the County Council can consider implementing a Residents Permit Parking scheme.

A residents permit scheme aims to restrict the use of on-street parking spaces so they are only available for use by residents within a designated area. Each household within the designated area would be able to apply for a maximum of two permits, one allocated against a specific vehicle registration and the second 'visitor' permit can be used by any vehicle, including family and friends when visiting. There is a £15 administration charge per permit per year. The area proposed for the permit scheme on Ingram Road is shown overleaf.

I am therefore writing to ask for your views on this proposal.
